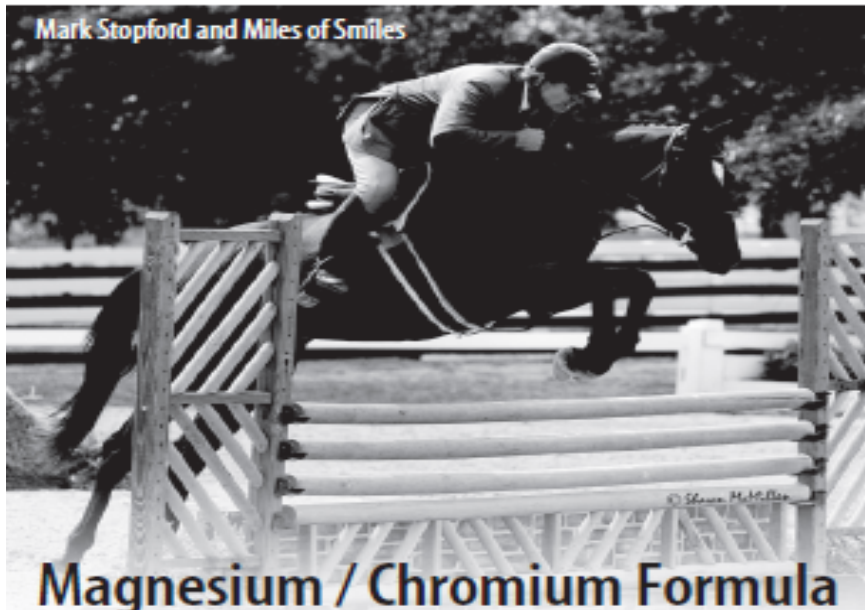

Saturday June 30th, Not Before 2 P.M.

Entry Fee: \$50

72. Open to all Juniors and Amateurs exhibitors. Riders should be entered by 12:00 noon on the day of competition. Any entries received after that time will be added to the top of their respective order. No entries will be accepted after 1 hour prior to competition. An order of go will be posted no later than one hour prior to the start of competition. The class will consist of one equitation over fences round and one flat equitation phase to be counted equally. The first round will consist of an equitation type of course of at least 10 fences. In the flat equitation phase riders will be asked to show at a walk, trot, canter, and counter canter both directions of the ring. The judge may call back a limited number of exhibitors for testing using the guidelines of USEF tests 1-19. The class will be offered at 2'6", 3', and 3'3". 2'6" horses will compete first. Riders who have competed in classes with fences 3' or higher during the current competition season may only compete at the 3' or 3'3" height. Courses may include an in and out, trot fences, and (footing permitted) riders may be asked to jump in and out of the ring and perform over an outside course. Numeric Scores will be given. The height at which the horse will compete must be declared at time of entry. No Unjudged Warm-up rounds immediately prior to start of the class

Any entries received after that time will be added to the top of their respective order. No entries will be accepted after 1 hour prior to competition. An order of go will be posted no later than 1 hour prior to the start of competition. The class will consist of four phases:

I. Written Exam

II. Equitation O/F

III. Equitation Derby

IV. Equitation on the Flat work off

The first phase will consist of a written horsemanship exam. The exam will be distributed no later than Monday August 20th. Exams should be typed and emailed to tdeckel@icloud.com no later than Friday August 24th at noon.

The over fences phases will consist of at least 8 obstacles and will be offered at three heights: 2'6", 3', and 3'3". Horse/Rider Combinations may not have competed in classes with fence height exceeding their declared height during the current show season. Riders who have competed in classes with fences 3'3" or higher during the current competition season may only compete at the 3' or 3'3" height. Courses may include an in and out, combination, trot fences, and (footing permitted) riders may be asked to jump in and out of the ring and perform over an outside course. The height at which the horse will compete must be declared at time of entry.

All entries will be required to compete in the latest Tad Coffin Performance Saddle Technology provided by Tad Coffin and Memory's Hill Stables.

Numeric Scores will be given in all phases. Each phase will be pinned individually. Points will be awarded in each class based on a 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, .5 table. At the completion of all four phases, point totals will be calculated and the class will be pinned from the total number of points awarded per rider. CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

2, 3, 4. SCHOOLING HUNTER – Open to all horses and ponies. Judged on performance, manners and way of going. Fences 2'6".

5, 6, 7. GREEN HUNTER - Open to horses only in their first or second year of showing over fences at 2'6" or higher. Fences to be 2'6" and 3'. Both heights must be offered and judged together. To be eligible for green hunter status, horses may not have shown over fences 2'6" or higher prior to the current competition year. A horse is eligible for reinstatement of their 1st green year if they have not shown at more than (3) shows over fences at 2'6" or higher prior to August 1st of the competition year upon application to the SWVHJA office. The application will be reviewed by the Board of Directors. Horses are eligible for (1) reinstatement of Green status. SWVHJA Recognized.

8, 9, 10. LOW HUNTER - Open to horses and ponies. To be judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Fences 3'. SWVHJA Recognized.

11, 12, 13. WORKING HUNTER - Open to horses. To be judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Fences 3'3" or 3'6". SWVHJA and VHSA Associate Recognized.

14, 15, 16. ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER - Open to adult amateur riders mounted on horses or ponies. To be judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Ponies shown by an adult may not be shown in the Pony Hunter division at the same horse show. Fences 3'. Management may combine this division with the Children's Hunter division if there are fewer than 3 entries. SWVHJA and VHSA Associate Recognized.

17, 18, 19. CHILDREN'S HUNTER - Open to juniors mounted on horses. To be judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Fences 3'. Management may combine this division with the Adult Amateur Hunter division if there are fewer than 3 entries. SWVHJA and VHSA Associate Recognized.

20, 21, 22. ADULT HUNTER PLEASURE HORSE– Open to horses ridden by an adult. SWVHJA and VHSA Associate Recognized.

23, 24, 25. HUNTER PLEASURE PONY - Open to juniors mounted on ponies. SWVHJA and VHSA Associate Recognized.

26, 27, 28. JR. HUNTER PLEASURE HORSE-Open to horses ridden by a junior. SWVHJA and VHSA Associate Recognized.

29, 30, 31. PLEASURE HUNTER - Open to all horses and ponies. Judged on performance, manners and way of going. Fences to be 18" and 2'. No oxers.

32, 33, 34. PRE-BEGINNER EQUITATION-Open to Junior and Amateur Riders in their first year of showing over fences less than 2' in height. Riders are eligible for one horse show year and may not enter divisions with fence height 2' or above. This division will not count against the rider's one year eligibility for the Beginner Equitation division. To be judged on rider's position and control. Division may be combined with Beginner Equitation division at managements discretion if entries warrant. Fence height 18". No oxers permitted. SWVHJA Recognized.

35, 36, 37. BEGINNER EQUITATION – Open to junior and amateur riders in their first year of showing over fences 2' in height. No oxers permitted. Riders are eligible for one horse show year and may not enter divisions with fence heights exceeding 2'. This division will not count against rider's 2 year eligibility for the Intermediate Hunter division. To be judged on rider's position and control. Division may be split between juniors and adults at the discretion of show management. SWVHJA Recognized.

38, 39, 40. HOPEFUL HUNTER -Open to all horses and ponies. Judged on performance, manners and way of going. Fences 2'3".

73, 74., 75. OPEN HUNTER- Open to all horses and ponies. Judged on performance, manners and way of going. Fences 2'6".

76, 77, 78- THOROUGHRED HUNTER– Open to horses registered with or are eligible to be registered with the Jockey Club. To be judged on performance and soundness. Fences 2'6" or 3'- VHSA Associate Recognized

CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

41, 42, 43. INTERMEDIATE HUNTER - Open to anyone in their first or second year of showing, on horses or ponies, excluding the Pre-Beginner and Beginner Equitation division. Fences 2'3". Once a rider shows over fences 2'6" or higher they are no longer eligible for the Intermediate Hunter division in subsequent years. To be judged on performance, manners, and way of going. The rider may not jump higher than 2'6" at the same horse show. SWVHJA Recognized.

44, 45, 46. SPECIAL ADULT HUNTER - Open to Adult Amateur riders mounted on horses or ponies. Fences to be 2'6" or 2'9". Both heights must be offered and judged together. Related distances between two jumps should be no less than 60' (4 strides). Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Horse/rider combination cannot compete over fences higher than 2'9" at the same horse show. Ponies shown by an adult may not be shown in the pony hunter division at the same horse show. The Special Adult Hunter division and the Special Children's Hunter division may be combined if there are fewer than 3 in either section. SWVHJA Recognized.

47, 48, 49. SPECIAL CHILDREN'S HUNTER - Same specs as the Special Adult Hunter, except open to junior riders. SWVHJA Recognized.

50, 51, 52. SMALL/MEDIUM PONY HUNTER - Open to ponies ridden by juniors. Ponies shown in this division may not be shown by an adult in any recognized division at the same horse show. Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Small ponies (not to exceed 12.2h) to jump 2', medium ponies (over 12.2h - not to exceed 13.2h) to jump 2'3". Divisions must be offered split, but if there are not three ponies in either the Small/Medium or Large Pony Divisions, the divisions must be combined. Lines less than 72' must be set on appropriate distances. SWVHJA and VHSA Associate Recognized.

53, 54, 55. LARGE PONY HUNTER - Open to ponies ridden by juniors. Ponies shown in this division may not be shown by an adult in any recognized division at the same horse show. Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Large ponies (over 13.2h - not to exceed 14.2h) to jump 2'6". Divisions must be offered split, but if there are not three ponies in either the Small/Medium or Large Pony divisions, the divisions must be combined. Lines less than 72' must be set on appropriate distances. SWVHJA and VHSA Associate Recognized.

73,74., 75. OPEN HUNTER- Open to all horses and ponies. Judged on performance, manners and way of going. Fences 2'6".

76, 77, 78- THOROUGHRED HUNTER- Open to horses registered with or are eligible to be registered with the Jockey Club. To be judged on performance and soundness. Fences 2'6" or 3'- VHSA Associate Recognized

67. LEADLINE—Open to riders six years of age and under. Riders may not cross enter into any other class at the horse show.

59. ADULT EQUITATION ON THE FLAT - Open to amateurs 18 years of age and older. To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring and judged on position, control, and guidance. USEF tests 1-19 may be used, excluding those requiring work over fences. Three entries are necessary to fill this class. Riders need not be members of SWVHJA to compete. If there are insufficient entries, this class may be combined with the Junior Equitation on the flat. Riders must stay within their age group if classes are split by age. SWVHJA and VHSA Associate Recognized.

60. JUNIOR EQUITATION ON THE FLAT 14 & Under - Open to riders who have not reached their 15th birthday by December 1st of the calendar year. To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring and judged on position, control, and guidance. USEF tests 1-19 may be used, excluding those requiring work over fences. Three entries are necessary to fill this class. Riders need not be members of SWVHJA to compete. If there are insufficient entries, this class may be combined with the Junior Equitation on the Flat 15-17 and/or the Adult Equitation on the flat.. SWVHJA and VHSA Associate Recognized.

61. JUNIOR EQUITATION ON THE FLAT 15-17 - Open to riders who have reached their 15th birthday by December 1st of the calendar year, but not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the calendar year. To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring and judged on position, control, and guidance. USEF tests 1- 19 may be used, excluding those requiring work over fences. Three entries are necessary to fill this class. Riders need not be members of SWVHJA to compete. If there are insufficient entries, this class may be combined with the Junior Equitation on the Flat 14 & under and/or the Adult Equitation on the flat. SWVHJA and VHSA Associate Recognized.

CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

56. SWVHJA ADULT MEDAL - Same specs as for the SWVHJA Hunter Seat Medal Class, except open to amateur riders 18 years of age and older. Ponies may be ridden by adults, but may not be shown in the Pony Hunter division at the same horse show. If there are fewer than four entries, this class can be combined with the Hunter Seat Medal. SWVHJA Adult Medal contestants may compete throughout the year. The top twenty (20) point earners, with a minimum of 10 points, will be invited to compete in the Adult Medal Finals.

57. SWVHJA HUNTER SEAT MEDAL - Open to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the calendar year. To be shown over a course of fences not to exceed 3' that must include two changes of direction, a combination and at least three oxers. A minimum of six riders, if available, must be called back to work on the flat. Martingales may not be used in the flat phase. Each phase to count 50%. Same horse must be used for both phases. To qualify for the finals, a rider must accumulate 20 points during the show year. Four entries are required to fill the class with a minimum of three to complete the class. If there are fewer than four entries, this class can be combined with the Adult Medal. SWVHJA Hunter Seat Medal contestants may compete throughout the year. The top twenty (20) point earners, with a minimum of 10 points, will be invited to compete in the Hunter Seat Medal Finals.

58. SWVHJA PONY MEDAL - Open to current junior members of SWVHJA mounted on ponies. To be shown over a minimum of 6 jumps at the appropriate heights. A minimum of six riders, if available, must be called back to work on the flat. Martingales may not be used in the flat phase. Each phase to count 50%. The same pony must be used for both phases. Four entries are required to fill the class with a minimum of three to complete the class. If no Pony Medal is offered, a rider may compete on a pony in the Hunter Seat Medal. A rider cannot compete in both the Pony and the Hunter Seat Medals in one show, nor can they participate in both aforementioned finals in one year. SWVHJA Pony Medal contestants may compete throughout the year. The top twenty (20) point earners, with a minimum of 10 points, will be invited to compete in the Pony Medal Finals.

79. HOLLINS MEDAL—Open to junior and adult amateur riders who have not qualified for the SWVHJA Hunter Seat Medal, SWVHJA Adult Medal, or the Oakridge Medal during the existing or previous year; qualifiers for the SWVHJA Pony medal are still eligible. The class will consist of 2 phases, each counting for 50% of the total score. First phase shall be shown over a course of fences and will not contain a combination. The second phase will be a flat phase, shown at the walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring. The same horse must be used for both phases. Martingales are permitted in the flat phase.

80. VHSA ADULT AMATEUR MEDAL—Open to horses only. Contestant must be a member of VHSA prior to entry in the class according to Article II, 3. and must hold a current amateur card issued by USEF. To be shown over a course of not less than six (6) obstacles at three (3) feet, which must include one combination and two changes of direction. All VHSA Adult Medal Class courses must have at least two of the following inside the course: a roll back turn, a broken or bending line, an end jump, a narrow jump, or a long ride to a single jump. Rider may not compete in any class where the fence height exceeds 3 feet, 3 inches, with the exception of the Children/Adult Jumper Division, at the same show. Beginning with the 2011 Show Year the VHSA Adult Medal Class no longer has a flat phase. The judge must call back at least four exhibitors for further testing. Jumping faults of mount not to count. Fall of horse or rider or three disobediences shall eliminate a contender. Judges may require riders to change horses, mount, dismount, or exhibit any other individual requirements of equitation they may deem necessary. There must be at least three (3) exhibitors to fill the class and three (3) exhibitors must complete the course in order for that particular class to count. Six Ribbons. This Medal cannot be combined with any other VHSA Medal or any other Division/Class.

81. VHSA CHILDREN'S MEDAL- Open to Junior members of VHSA who have not reached their 18th birthday and who have not jumped higher than three feet at a show where entered in the Children's Hunter Division, except in Equitation. Contestant must be a member of VHSA prior to entry in the class according to Article II, 3. Open to horses only. To be shown over a course of not less than six (6) obstacles at three (3) feet, which must include one combination and two changes of direction. All VHSA Medal Class courses must have at least two of the following inside the course: a roll back turn, a broken or bending line, an end jump, a narrow jump, or a long ride to a single jump. Beginning with the 2011 Show Year the VHSA Children's Medal Class no longer has a flat phase. The judge must call back at least four exhibitors for further testing. Fall of horse or rider or three disobediences shall eliminate a contender. Judges may require riders to change horses, mount, dismount or exhibit any other individual requirements of equitation they may deem necessary. There must be at least three (3) exhibitors to fill the class and three (3) exhibitors must complete the course in order for that particular class to count. Six Ribbons. This Medal cannot be combined with any other VHSA Medal or any other Division/Class.

82. SWEET BRIAR COLLEGE MEDAL—Open to juniors and amateurs. To be shown over a course of no less than 6 jumps at 2'9". Course must include 2 changes of direction, and may contain an in and out. The judge will then have the option of testing the top 4 riders. Tests 1-10 may be used. The same horse must be used in both phases. Three competitors must complete the course for points to count. Riders may not have shows in a 3'6" or higher Equitation medal class, and may not jump higher than 2'9" at the same show. This class may be combined with other classes of similar specifications. This class is not recognized or sanctioned by SWVHJA. Finals will be held at the Sweet Briar College Winter Horse Show in December. To qualify for the finals, a rider must accumulate 20 points, or be in the top 15 point earners for the year. Riders may continue to compete throughout the year.
